



2019 Summer Study Quiz #2

Play Situations:

For a Complete Play Analysis (CPA) exercise, provide the following information in your answer for each of the 15 Quiz #2 questions: 1) Name of Foul, 2) Type of Play, 3) Basic Spot, 4) Enforcement Spot, 5) Team, 6) Down, 7) Distance, 8) Yard-line, 9) Penalty Distance, 10) Rule/Section/Article, 11) Play Clock, 12) Game Clock, 13) Other Notes (i.e., DQ, 10 SRO, send-off, etc.). Unless specified, all plays start with more than 3 minutes remaining in any quarter.

- 1. A 3/6 at B-32:** The score is A-26 B-28 and there are six seconds remaining in the game. A18's field-goal attempt is blocked and A32 recovers the ball on the B-38. At the end of the play, the game clock reads 0:01. There were five Team A players in the backfield at the snap. Team B accepts the penalty.
- 2. A 2/8 at A-4:** QB A11 receives the snap and is standing in the end zone when he is hit as he is throwing a forward pass. The ball floats, so A70 tries to catch the misdirected pass to prevent B99 from intercepting it. A70 muffs the forward pass in the end zone and it falls incomplete at the A-1. Team B accepts the penalty.
- 3. A FK at A-35:** A13 kicks an onside kick that bounces twice and pops high into the air. B88 leaps in an attempt to catch the kick at the A-44 but muffs the ball. The ball rolls to the A-48 where A27 falls on the ball. A27 gets up and spikes the ball.
- 4. A 2/11 at A-24:** QB A11 takes the shotgun snap and has to scramble to his left under pressure from B93. Left Guard A62 reaches out to block B93 and grabs and pulls B93's face mask causing B93 to spin around at the A-19. A11 completes a pass to A18 at the A-41 where he is shoved out of bounds.
- 5. A 1/10 at A-25:** QB A11 takes the snap and hands off to running back A22 at the A-20. A22 rolls to the right outside the tackle box and is at the A-18 in a passing posture looking downfield for an open receiver when B51 rushing unabated hits him forcibly at the knee. A22 is able to maintain his balance and, unable to find an open receiver, he runs to the A-45 where he is hit and fumbles the ball. The ball rolls out of bounds at the A-40.
- 6. A TRY at B-3:** A14's kick is blocked and picked up by B55. During B55's return, A41 blocks B99 low. B55 is brought down by his hair at the A-15 by A22.

- 7. A 1/G at B-10:** A80 is a wide out on the end of the line. A80 and A99 both have a foot touching the B-10 (i.e. "on the line") with no stagger, and there are 4 other players clearly in the backfield. A80 runs a fade to the corner and A99 runs an out route just short of the B-6 where he turns toward the sideline. QB A11 throws a pass to A80 that is caught in the end zone.
- 8. A 3/9 at A-2:** QB A11 takes the snap four yards deep in the end zone. Defensive tackle B69 rips through A60 and pursues the scrambling QB. During the scramble A60 grabs B69's ankle taking him to the ground at the A-2. The Referee has a flag down for holding on A60 at the A-1. A11 is tackled at the A-1. B declines the penalty.
- 9. A 4/10 at A-45:** A14's punt is rolling on the ground when it hits the leg of A88 at the B-12. B44 tries to pick up the kick but muffs the ball. To prevent a recovery by Team A, B99 kicks the ball backward from the B-10 so that it goes into the end zone and out of bounds behind the goal line. Team A accepts the penalty.
- 10. A 3/10 at 50:** Team A is leading 30-24 with 0:50 remaining in the game. The clock is running at the snap. QB A11 is dropped for a loss at the A-45 and during the down A66 is called for illegal hands to the face of B99 at the A-48. Team B accepts the penalty.
- 11. A 2/7 at A-40:** QB A11 drops back to pass. Receiver A35 runs his route in front of B55. As A35 runs in front of B55, B55 sticks his foot and trips A35. A11 was sacked at the A-30.
- 12. A 4/7 at A-33:** Punter A15 muffs the snap and then picks up the loose ball and begins running. At the A-35 he punts the ball down field. B88 catches the kick at the B-40 with A44 only 12 inches in front of him, after B88 signals for a fair catch. After the play, the officiating crew huddled and concluded that the fair-catch was during a dead-ball. Team B accepts the penalty.
- 13. 5th Extra Period:** Team A elects to take the ball.
- 14. A 1/10 at A-42:** On a sweep play to the right, lead blocker A65 is on the A-44 and the ball carrier A20 is outside the tackle box. B23 goes low and blocks A65 below the waist outside the 10-2 area. A20 is tackled inbounds at the A-48.
- 15. A 4/3 at B-26:** A14's field goal attempt is blocked by B99 and the ball hits the ground at the B-15 and goes out of bounds at the B-10. After the play is over, B99 takes his helmet off in celebration while in the middle of the field.

Supplemental Guidelines:

The answers should be T/F. Reference the page of the Supplemental Guidelines used for your answer, then give brief explanation for your answer.

1. HL will ensure chain crew is on sideline three minutes prior to the start of the game.
2. After the down ends and Team A substitutes, all deep officials will extend their arms to signal substitution.
3. With less than two minutes in the half and the down ends with the ball inbounds and the game clock continuing to run, the ball used during the last down should be used for the next down.
4. Team A is in punt formation at the 50-yard line. At the snap, the LJ will leave the LOS and begin to drift downfield 5-7 yards. When the snap is complete move further downfield to cover the punt.
5. If the attempted FG or PAT is wide (no good) only the official on the side the ball went wide will give the signal.
6. When the referee is making an announcement on the stadium microphone, it is permissible for the calling official to relay information to other officials about the penalty over the O2O headset.
7. If a punt is blocked, the referee will rotate toward the middle of the field IF the position and direction of the blocked kick allows.
8. If the punt is blocked, or there is an errant snap that is grounded, the referee has primary responsibility for acts to or possession of the football from sideline to sideline.
9. Team A lines up for a PAT. There is a bad snap or fake and subsequently a run or pass occurs. The flank officials should immediately move to the pylon and be responsible for goal line as well as the sideline all the way to the end line.
10. Team A lines up for a punt at the 50-yard line. The deep officials are responsible for knowing the number of the eligible players in formation on their side of the field.
11. Team A lines up for a punt, the referee has primary responsibility for knowing the numbering exceptions on the LOS.
