



2019 Summer Study Quiz #3

Play Situations:

For a Complete Play Analysis (CPA) exercise, provide the following information in your answer for each of the 15 Quiz #3 questions: 1) Name of Foul, 2) Type of Play, 3) Basic Spot, 4) Enforcement Spot, 5) Team, 6) Down, 7) Distance, 8) Yard-line, 9) Penalty Distance, 10) Rule/Section/Article, 11) Play Clock, 12) Game Clock, 13) Other Notes (i.e., DQ, 10 SRO, send-off, etc.). Unless specified, all plays start with more than 3 minutes remaining in any quarter.

- 1. A 4/9 at B-49:** A15's punt hits on the B-4 and bounces over the goal line and is airborne when A44 bats it back into the field of play. The kick is recovered by B33 on the B-4 and he advances to the B-17 before being tackled. During the kick, B19 blocked A30 in the back on the B-25. Team A accepts the penalty.
- 2. A 1/10 at B-40:** A11 throws a pass from the B-47 to A80 who catches it at the B-32 and runs for a touchdown. While pass blocking behind the line of scrimmage, A74 puts a hand under the chin of B94 and pins his head back for an extended period.
- 3. A 3/4 at A-41:** Prior to the snap, with game clock running, defensive tackle B74, who is lined up on the line of scrimmage directly across from right guard A62, yells out a cadence and flinches his arms forward but does not break the neutral zone. Immediately after the action by B74, right tackle A79 flinches in his stance. The HL and LJ blow their whistles, throw their flags and kill the play.
- 4. A 4/7 at A-13:** A15 punts the ball deep to B80 who catches the ball at the B-40 and advances to the A-45 where he is tackled by A74. Prior to the kick, A27 holds B88 at the A-14. During the return, B55 blocks A77 below the waist at the B-38. Team B wants to keep the ball.
- 5. A FK at A-35:** Kicker A12 tries a surprise onside kick and barely strikes the top of the ball. The ball is slowly rolling at the A-36 when A12 is mad and kicks the loose ball downfield. The ball rolls out of bounds untouched by any player at the B-40.
- 6. A 4/5 at B-30:** Team A attempts a field goal that is blocked by B86. The ball bounces in the field of play and rolls into and out of Team B's end zone. While the kick is rolling beyond the neutral zone, B88 holds A22 at the B-25.
- 7. A FK at A-35:** A12 kicks the ball high and deep. B12 catches the ball at the B-5 and runs to the B-15 where he is tackled by A33. The SJ has a flag down as A33 stepped out of bounds on his own at the A-45. Team B wants to keep the ball.

- 8. A 2/10 at A-25:** As QB A11 is in the pocket, B68 sheds A70 and in an attempt to block the pass forcibly brings his arms down striking A11 in the face mask with his forearm. A88 catches the ball and is tackled at the A-45.
- 9. A 3/7 at A-40:** QB A11 is scrambling outside the tackle box and under heavy pressure. After releasing a forward pass, B55 grabs A11 by the back of his collar and immediately pulls him to the ground at the A-35. A22 catches the pass and carries it to the A-45 where he is pushed out of bounds.
- 10. A 4/G at B-4:** The game clock has 4 seconds remaining in the game and is running when the ball is snapped. Wide out A88, positioned on the line of scrimmage 10 yards outside of the tackle box at the snap, moves toward the original position of the snap and blocks B66 below the waist from the side in the end zone. A32 scores a TD on the play and time expires.
- 11. A 4/5 at B-40:** QB A11 drops back to pass as B97 rushes off the edge. As A11 begins his passing motion, B97 leads with the crown of his helmet and hits A11 in the ribs, driving him into the ground at the 50. A11 was able to hold onto the ball during the tackle.
- 12. A 3/5 at B-35:** A44 is lined up in a stationary position slightly behind the right tackle. At the snap, A44 moves to his left and blocks the blitzing LB below the waist from the side, directly behind where the ball was snapped. RB A34 runs for a 10-yard gain and is tackled inbounds.
- 13. A 4/10 at A-45:** A12's punt is rolling on the ground when it hits the leg of A88 at the B-12. B44 tries to pick up the kick but muffs the ball. To prevent a recovery by Team A, B99 kicks the ball backward from the B-10 so that it goes into the end zone and out of bounds behind the goal line. Team A declines the penalty.
- 14. A FK at A-35:** During the kick, B44 and B48 touch hands at the B-30 in order to align with one another and move up field to block. The kick is muffed by receiver B14 and it rolls out of bounds at the B-12. Team A accepts the penalty.
- 15. A 1/10 at A-40:** Team A runs a reverse, and A78 blocks lineman B65 outside of his field of vision at the A-38. The block is forcible with significant thrust and contact is made at the side of B45. Runner A33 is tackled inbounds at the A-48.

Supplemental Guidelines:

The answers should be T/F. Reference the page of the Supplemental Guidelines used for your answer, then give brief explanation for your answer.

1. Prior to the snap, tackle B77 who is in a three-point stance head up on the offensive tackle, makes a sudden and abrupt move toward the gap between tackle and guard. His movement is at an angle and does not quite enter into the neutral zone. The offensive tackle reacts immediately to B77's movement. Ruling: Team A should be called for a false start.
2. If a player is in "chase-mode" and attempts to block an opponent, and one of the blockers hands is on the arm and the other hand is on the back, it will be an illegal block in the back if the primary force is from the side.
3. A grab of an opponent's jersey which stretches the jersey will be called holding.
4. Team A runs a play which ends with the ballcarrier going out of bounds in the OPPONENT'S team area. The referee will automatically institute substitution mechanics with outstretched arms.
5. As the runner approaches the 50-yard line, he decides to "slow up", turns his body toward the sideline and attempts to step out of bounds. Prior to his foot coming down out of bounds Team B player forcibly (not targeting) contacts the runner from behind below the waist. Ruling: Legal:
6. Fourth and 2 at the B-5. Runner A32 goes airborne, his left wrist first touches the ground at the B-2, and then before any other part of his body touches he reaches forward and breaks the goal line plane with the football in his right hand. Ruling: B 1-10 at the dead ball spot.
7. If a player is ejected from a game involving NCFC member schools, the referee and the official who ejected the player will send a brief descriptive email to Dave C by 2PM the next day.
8. The **primary responsibility** for viewing the development of the "wedge" by Team B on a free kick belongs to the HL and LJ.
9. Back judge has **primary responsibility** for game clock during the game and communicating with the referee status of the clock between downs.
10. During warm-ups, if both teams are near the mid-field area, the referee and umpire are responsible for managing player behavior and potential taunting that may occur during this interval.
11. Team A has 4th and 12 at the 50-yard line and the punt team is sent in. When in scrimmage kick formation prior to the snap, Team A has 4 numbering exceptions aligned in the interior, including #35 the snapper. The kicker fakes a kick and passes

the ball downfield to #35 who is tackled after a twenty-yard gain. At the end of the down, the umpire should have a flag for ineligible downfield.

12. Second and 5 at the 50-yard line. Play goes off tackle, and after gaining 4 yards is tackled near the sideline. The off-side flank official should provide a cross field spot after moving as near as the top of the numbers as the dead ball action allows.
13. It is optional whether the side officials will change sidelines at start of second half.
14. If there is a dead ball foul prior to the snap, the referee will provide a preliminary and final signal as the umpire marks off the penalty.
